Presidential Message

The past year has been a challenging one for all of us on every front. We appear to be getting to the other side of this pandemic and the latest numbers show great reductions in the number of cases, hospitalizations etc. The Board has worked diligently to stay on top of all the challenges regarding continuing education due to the severe reductions in in person courses being offered. We moved to allow all CE be taken online until the Governors Emergency Order expires, currently that is July 6th. The number of in person courses has begun to increase but is still not back to pre covid numbers. The latest numbers show roughly 12 in person and 200 online classes. Barring any extensions of the Governors order we will resume normal CE allowances July the $7^{\rm th}$. All online classes have to be in the board office by 4pm July the $6^{\rm th}$ for consideration.

I am happy to report that the number of complaints are down as compared to previous years. We did have a slight increase during the peak of the early part of the pandemic but these were mostly driven out of frustration of dealing with all the issues of closure, mask orders etc.

We are heading into the final stretch of renewal and I would like to remind everyone to make sure your hours are turned into the Board as soon as possible to allow time for input of your information. We typically have a large number of last minute filings and it creates difficulty in properly crediting your hours by the deadline.

2021-22 ONLINE RENEWAL

Online Renewal will open August 15. The process goes much smoother if you have all of the required documents in to the Board prior to this date.

Continuing Education Required:

New Licensees who graduated within the previous 12 months 4 AL Law

Active License Total of 18—6 may be online 2 must be AL Law

Inactive License Total of 18—6 may be online 2 must be AL Law

Any licensee practicing in AL for more than 2 years must have a Section 136 Business License. For the 2021-22 Renewal the expiration on the Business License must be September 30, 2021. We receive multiple city and county business licenses each year. We do not need this one.

FINAL DAY TO OBTAIN ALL 18 CCE HOURS FOR RENEWAL ONLINE


Per a motion at the January 2021 Meeting the Board approved all hours for renewal to be taken online until the end of the Governor's State of Emergency. The Governor's latest amendment to the State of Emergency extends the date to July 6, 2021. Therefore you have until July 6, 2021 to take all 18 hours online if you choose to do so. Your certificates must be in to the Board Office prior to 4 PM on July 6, 2021. We do not expect another extension from the Governor.
