Presidential Message

The Board recently held our fiscal year end meeting September 15-18 and we discussed the possible need to raise our licensing fees. I am pleased to report that we did not raise the fee but we will continue to evaluate the costs we are incurring and make any necessary adjustments in the future. We also discussed the anticipated legislation to require our x-ray technicians to be licensed or registered with the state. The Board has never had a complaint involving the taking of x-rays. We worked with the ASCA the past two years in opposing this license. I would like to encourage everyone that is concerned with this legislation to speak with your representatives or the ASCA and let them know your position. If this bill passes without exempting our profession we will incur additional costs in both personnel and licensing of the technician.

The complaints are at an all time low this past year. We have had a couple of complaints regarding clinics not obtaining the required permits due to changes in corporate structure. I encourage you to reach out to the board if you change your practice structure to make sure you remain compliant.

We are still in the thick of renewal and I recommend you get your license renewed as soon as possible. The first late fee goes into effect October 1st but you can avoid any additional late fees by renewing prior to November 1st. We have had more people renew this year by September 30th than last year. We have had several licensees state they were having a difficult time getting to in person CE classes but the numbers are up compared to prior years. The ASCA changed their yearly convention meeting to three regional meetings enabling easier access for the north and south doctors.

The board would like to introduce our newest board employee Melissa Fowler. Melissa is an Administrative Assistant II. If you have a need to call the Board Office please welcome her.


