The Board voted to extend the online continuing education until the end of the current renewal cycle but has not yet decided whether to extend it for next year. I participated in a zoom conference with the Federation of Chiropractic Licensing Boards last year to discuss all of the pros and cons of allowing online CE and the outcome was no real consensus as how to best address or allow CE hours to be obtained online. The Board will continue to evaluate the CE issues and address them as the status of the pandemic and availability of in person seminars become known.

We are currently in renewal time and I would like to encourage you to get it completed as soon as possible to avoid any delays and give you time to address any issues that may develop. We continue to have licensees take courses that have not been approved for CE in Alabama and this can cause a lot of frustration as well as late fees and can easily be avoided by checking to make sure the class is approved prior to registering or attending. The Board maintains a list of approved seminars to assist you in this process and it can be viewed on the Board's website.

I would like to thank everyone for your patience over the last year as the Board has navigated through the issues of the pandemic and replacing and training new staff. The Board staff are adapting well and seem to be operating close to full speed and work diligently to address your questions and concerns.

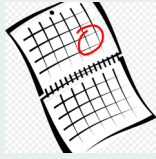
