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Regular meeting of the Alabama State Board of Chiropractic Examiners, Friday June 5, 2026, at the Embassy Suites by Hilton (Hoover), Birmingham, Alabama.

Prior notice of the meeting has been given in accordance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act.

Roll was called. Those attending were: Dr. Bowen – President, Dr. Russell – Vice President, Dr. McMillian - Secretary/Treasurer. Members – Drs. Randolph, Ogletree, Millar, Youngblood, Stewart and Mr. Segrest. Amy Deavers, Executive Director, Kerry Forbus, Executive Assistant and Mr. Brom Board Attorney. Absent: Dr Randolph and. Guests: Nathaniel Nunez Chevere, Hugh Harris, Brad Adams, Brian Wells, Isabella Hill, Ethan Holm, Ben Smith, Brittany Post, Harlen, Post , Travis A Lowman, Carter Pierce, Brianna Stokes, Frank Grant Lassiter, Alexis Love, Collin Bowen, Jennifer McGehee, Donna Fisher and David Smith.

Dr. Bowen announced quorum existed and called the meeting to order at 6:05 PM.

Motion #1 was made by Dr. Russell and seconded by Mr. Segrest, “I move the Board **ratify** the **minutes** for **March 13, 2026.**” Ayes- All. Nays-None PASSED

Amy Deavers gave the Financial Report.

Motion #2 was made by Dr. McMillian and seconded by Dr. Stewart, “I move the Board **adopt** the **Financial Report** as given.” PASSED / unanimous

Board discussed the need for a new larger Boardroom Display Screen and reviewed the quotes received.

Motion #3 was made by Dr. Russell and seconded by Dr. McMillian, “I move the Board **table** the discussion until the August meeting.” PASSED / unanimous

Board discussed the require a retired Licensee take SPEC or a certain number of hours if they want to go back to active after 5 years that was tabled from the March meeting.

Board discussed companies restrict chiropractors from purchasing injectable nutrients due to pharmacy board registration requirements and archaic statutory language causes ambiguity.

Dr. Bowen gave a report on the legislative session for 2026.
